# Subhashitani - Meaning:

Sloka 1: How can a lazy person acquire knowledge? Without knowledge how will one get wealth? Without wealth who will become friends? And without friends how will anyone become happy?

Sloka 2: Knowledge gives humility, from humility, one attains character; From character, one acquires wealth; from wealth good deeds (righteousness) follow and then happiness.

#### Sloka 3:

- Real ornament of throat is by speaking the truth.
